

DOMICILIARY TREATMENT

Medical Expenses incurred in respect of the following diseases which need domiciliary treatment as may be certified by the recognised hospital authorities and banks medical officer shall be deemed as hospitalisation expenses and reimbursed to the extent of 100% in case of a workman and in the case of his family also.

Cancer, Leukaemia, Thalassemia, Tuberculosis, Paralysis, Cardiac Ailment, Pleuresy, Leprosy, Kidney ailment, Epilepsy, Parkinson's Disease, Psychiatric disorder, Diabetes, Hepatitis-B, Hepatitis-C, Haemophilia, Myastheniagravis, Wilsons disease, Ulcerative Colitis, Epidermolysis bullosa, Venous Thrombosis (not caused by smoking), Aplastic Anaemia, Psoriasis, Third Degree Burns, Rheumatoid Arthritis, Hypothyroidism and Hyperthyroidism.

Note:

- (i) The cost of medicines etc. in respect of domiciliary treatment shall be reimbursed for the period stated in the Specialist's prescription. If no period is stated, the prescription for the purpose of reimbursement shall be valid for a period not exceeding 90 days.
- (ii) Expenses incurred on radiotherapy and chemotherapy in the treatment of cancer and leukaemia shall be considered for reimbursement under domiciliary treatment to the extent of 100% in case of a workman and in the case of his family also.

G) Charges for Ventilator: Rs. 1,800/- to Rs. 2,400 i.e. Rs. 75/- to Rs.100/hr

(H) General : - Use of instruments, indispensable for operative interference, using the state-of-the-art medical techniques like -Laparoscopy, Phaco, Percutaneous Nephro Lithotomy (PCND. Laser etc. to be reimbursed as per advise of the Bank's Medical Officer.

If the stay of the patient exceeds the package period, the charges will be extra (Room rent, diet, professional and other investigation charges) the package does not cover the cost of prosthetic valve, intra-aortic balloon pump and imported drugs/materials visiting charges of Doctors outside package period will be charged extra-specialists services from Nephrology, Neurology, Diabetology and other departments and additional special investigations, will be charged extra.

(I) USE OF CYPHER STENT

Workmen staff may be reimbursed the cost of medicated/ ciper stent, on case to case basis, in the following cases where restenosis involves would involve high risk to the life of the patients.

- Osteal/ Proximal LAD lesions
- Stenosis of a. Coronary Artery, which is giving collaterals to 'another blocked artery thus supplying large area of myocardium
- Stenting of restenotic lesions after previous angioplasty.

A certificate from the attending doctor explaining circumstances necessitating use of medicated/ ciper stent and estimate containing description and cost of medicated / ciper stent duly verified and confirmed by the Bank's medical officer should support the recommendations for reimbursement of expenses.

The authority to grant administrative clearance to reimburse cost of medicated stents, subject to a maximum of two medicated stents with a maximum ceiling of Rs.1.20 lacs per medicated stent has been delegated to the General Manager (Network), subject to fulfillment of all the other terms and conditions under the scheme.

Proposals necessitating implantation of more than two medicated stents shall continue to be referred to Corporate Centre for administrative clearance.
